Who Can Enter

- The sale of raffle tickets is open to the general public
- Entrants under 18 years of age must obtain the prior permission of their parent or legal guardian in order to be able to enter.

How to Enter

- To enter the draw to win the Accessible Cubby House, a raffle ticket must be purchased. This raffle is a game of chance with the winner being drawn at random from the raffle tickets purchased.
- Raffle ticket sales will be available from Friday, 2nd November 2018 to Sunday 3rd November 2018 during the promoters stall hours at the launch of Play Town at Castletown, corner Woolcock St & King's Road, Hyde Park, Townsville QLD 4812.

- Raffle ticket sales close Friday 30th November 2018 4.30pm.

About the Prize

- The prize being raffled is an accessible Cubby House. Cubby house comes with a detachable accessible ramp, key lockable front door, LED downward lighting inside and out, flat screen TV, planter boxes, and electrical points to provide power to the cubby house.
- Cubby house dimensions: 3.3m tall, 3.62m long (without accessibility ramp), 1.88m wide,
- Detachable ramp dimension: 3.45m long, 1m wide.
- Cubby house with ramp: 7.07m long

Draw and announcement of winner

- A single winner will be drawn on Monday 3rd December 2018. The winner will be contacted by their provided phone number and/or email address within 5 business days of the draw.
- The winner will also be announced publicly on the promoter's social media platforms.

Delivery/collection of prize

- Included in the prize is one complimentary delivery courtesy of ASAP Scaffolding. The promoter will organise the delivery of the Cubby house with the winner to their nominated address. Once the Cubby House has been delivered to the nominated address, the promoter is not responsible for the moving of the Cubby House thereafter. Delivery is to be organised within six(6) weeks of the draw. Complimentary delivery is only available within Townsville.

Any delivery outside of Townsville will need to be organised at the expense of the winner within the agreed six(6) week period.
